Pastor's Report – 2024, Pastor Joe Boisvert

What a year! Though Motion Church has been in a period of transition since late 2023, I did not begin my role as your lead Pastor until mid-September 2024. When I arrived at Motion Church in September, everyone was looking up! I understand completely; Motion had Pastor Stewart Hunter as interim Pastor during the period from mid-January — September 2024, and it has been my experience that one cannot spend time with Pastor Stewart and his lovely wife, Gudrun, and not come away encouraged! God has a way of meeting us right where we are at, and He knew what He was doing when He sent them both to Morrisburg. Our great God places us all in the Body of Christ to fulfill specific roles that are unique and relative to how He has gifted each one of us. Pastor Stewart and Gudrun together were a listening ear, an encouraging voice, and an activating presence at Motion, encouraging many of you to embrace your God given gifts and use them for His glory. We are so thankful for their ministry during those eight months in 2024!

Since Candy, the kids and I began in September, we have been enormously blessed by the kindness and warm reception of each of you. We were blessed by the Tibben family as they gave up their home to accommodate us for our first three months in town; we were blessed in October during Pastor Appreciation Month with generous gifts of finances, food, and thoughtful cards and other gifts; then, at Thanksgiving, we were blessed again with even more, as you gifted us with special groceries, grocery cards, and homemade goods! That first three months must have added two inches to our waistlines, and several layers of warmth to our hearts. We are grateful that the Pastor's Council and all of you at Motion went to such lengths to make us feel welcome, as it has made our own transition to life in these new surroundings so much easier. We truly feel as though we've been at Motion much longer than the eight months we have; we feel like family already! Thank you, Motion Church. Our introduction to you has shown us that this church in the heart of Morrisburg is full of people who know well how to express the love of God. What will God do in Morrisburg with our hearts and hands submitted to Him?!

What did 2024 look like at Motion? When we arrived, monthly youth meetings were just beginning. There were monthly 55+ luncheons, and Women's events in place as well. The first thing the Council and I felt the Lord leading us to do after we arrived was to establish a weekly prayer meeting. Tuesday night prayer began in November. These times of prayer have proven to be foundational to what the Lord is doing at Motion.

Prayer is always the launch point. We see this most clearly in Scripture throughout the book of Acts, beginning with the disciples waiting and praying in Jerusalem in obedience to the Lord's command. As we pray, the Lord stirs our hearts for each other and our community and we begin to discern both His heart for the people of Morrisburg and surrounding communities, and then how He wants to use His Body at Motion (you and me), to impact those around us for His Kingdom. Not only does prayer help us to have the mind of Christ, but as we pray in faith, mountains begin to move!

A church that is truly following the Lord will be a church that is mindful of God's mission not only in our own backyard, but across the globe. During one of our prayer nights in November, we hosted a Cuban Pastor, José Losada, and he shared with us how he is working to encourage other pastors in Cuba to be faithful and trust the Lord in a harsh social and political environment. Motion Church was able to bless him with loads of items such as toiletries and medicines to bring back to Cuba with him! He was so blessed by your generosity, and with him, those in need who received those items in Cuba. Also in 2024, Motion was privileged to bless Bonita Abrams, a PAOC missionary in Cuba, as well as Cal and June Anthony, PAOC missionaries to Eurasia. During Pastor Stewart's time as Interim Pastor, Motion raised \$2100 for a special project that Cal and June are a part of in Croatia, the building of a children's camp where many kids and families will have the opportunity to hear the gospel message and be introduced to Jesus! What an impact Motion is having!

At home, Motion saw the breakdown of our accessibility lift in early December. While this has been a challenge, it has also been an opportunity to see God's faithfulness. Many of you gave financially before 2024 ended, but from where we sat at the end of 2024, it appeared the \$50,000 journey to a new lift was going to be a long, uphill climb. I'm not supposed to say much about 2025, as this is 2024's report, but I will say that from where we sit now, there is a new lift in place, it is fully paid for, and there are still eight months of the year left to go!

I want to take a moment here to thank all those who have volunteered their time to provide leadership in the various ministries of the church throughout 2024:

Jeannie Barkley took over the custodial duties from Johnny and Kristy Connors in 2024; Tom Dekker and Johnny Connors co-lead as grounds and building caretakers at Motion; Tom Dekker also leads the Ushering team; Jeannie, Janet Kwakye, and Naomi Boisvert have been co-leading the Music Team; Josie and Jeannie co-lead the Women in Motion events, as well as our monthly Sunday pot-luck luncheons and special meal events such as our Christmas Dinner; Judah Boisvert and Paul Essilfie-Bondzie have provided leadership in the sound room; Shelley Torrance has provided leadership in Guest and Café Services; and Jeannie Barkley has provided leadership with our Youth in Motion. Additionally, we have an amazing Pastor's Council consisting of Anita Hynes as

Treasurer, Jeannie Barkley as Secretary, and Paul Essilfie-Bondzie. Without such committed individuals serving as they do (and what's more, in a volunteer capacity), Motion Church could not function! Each of these individuals I've mentioned have a team of committed servant-leaders working with them to ensure that the physical and spiritual needs of the Body are attended to at Motion Church. Thank you to each of you who give your time, resources, finances, encouraging words, and prayer to the furtherance of God's Kingdom both here at Motion Church and in Morrisburg and surrounding areas. You are appreciated!!

As we look ahead to 2025, we can't help but anticipate what God will do in and through Motion Church. As we continue to submit to His leading, making ourselves available in whatever capacities He calls us to, I believe we will see growth in evangelistic Missions both local and global, in our Music, Children's, and Youth ministries as well as our Women's and 55+ ministries and, finally, in the birth of new ministries as the Lord leads. Treasurer's Report

2024 has been a fascinating year money wise.

As a church we've gone from being in debt and not being able to pay the bills to having close to \$15,000 in the bank.

We paid off a \$5,000 visa debt early in the year with donations given by the congregation.

We sent \$2,100 to missions for a children's camp in Serbia and \$400 to other missions. We replaced the roof over the main door at close to \$900.

As a church we have begun to tithe once again to district office, something we haven't done since I've been doing this job.

We have a small loan from EOD to pay. We have a balance of \$2000 which we are currently paying off.

In December 2024 we found out that the accessibility lift needed to be replaced at a cost of close to \$50 000. The congregation once again stepped up and we have paid it in full.

We have tithes coming in regularly from many in the congregation. We are receiving a subsidy from EOD monthly in the amount of \$2,500. I look forward to continuing to serve you at Motion Church.
